A RESOLUTION OF THE CANYON COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS TO WAIVE LANDFILL FEES FOR ONE CANYON COUNTY NUISANCE PROPERTY

The following Resolution was considered and adopted by the Canyon County, Idaho Board of Commissioners on the day of September, 2024
Upon the motion of Commissioner and the second by Commissioner the Board resolves as follows:
WHEREAS, Idaho Code § 31-801 grants general powers and duties, subject to the restrictions of law, to the boards of county commissioners in their respective counties; and
WHEREAS, Idaho Code § 31-828 grants the Board authority "to do and perform all other acts which may be necessary to the full discharge of the duties of the chief executive authority of the county government"; and
WHEREAS, the Board has the power pursuant to the Idaho Code and the Canyon County Solid Waste Disposal Regulations (County Ordinance) to establish, change, or modify fees at the Pickles Butte Landfill by resolution of the Board; and
WHEREAS, the Board desires to waive certain landfill fees for a Canyon County resident with property located at 17493 Goodson Rd, Caldwell, Idaho (parcel number R37892), which is currently in violation of Canyon County's Public Nuisance Ordinance, Chapter 2, Article 1 of the Canyon County Code of Ordinances; and
WHEREAS, the County will provide a letter to the County resident subject to this free trash month prior to October 20, 2024. A copy of that letter shall be provided to the Landfill scale house staff to make arrangements for the expected waste to be received;
NOW THEREFORE, THE BOARD HEREBY RESOLVES, that it is in the best interest of Canyon County to waive landfill fees for the Canyon County resident of the property described in this resolution which are currently in violation of Canyon County's Public Nuisance Ordinance, for one (1) month only, which month shall commence starting October 20, 2024 and concluding on November 20, 2024. The following shall apply: wood waste and metal should be separated from other waste, as should tires and refrigeration units.
