

RESOLUTION NO. 25-128

A RESOLUTION OF THE CANYON COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS TO MAKE  
APPOINTMENTS TO THE COUNTY HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION

The following resolution and order was considered and adopted by the Canyon County, Idaho Board of Commissioners ("Board") on this 10<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2025.

Upon the motion of Commissioner Van Brock and the second by Commissioner Brooks, the Board resolves as follows:

WHEREAS, Idaho Code § 31-801 grants general powers and duties, subject to the restrictions of law, to the boards of county commissioners in their respective counties; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code § 31-828 grants the Board authority "to do and perform all other acts . . . which may be necessary to the full discharge of the duties of the chief executive authority of the county government"; and

WHEREAS, Canyon County Code of Ordinances, Chapter 6, Article 3 (Ord. 91-001 and Ord. 91-002) establishes a Historic Preservation Ordinance pursuant to authority granted by title 67, chapter 46 of the Idaho Code; and




WHEREAS, the Canyon County Historic Preservation Ordinance provides, among other things, for the creation of a historic preservation commission and the appointment of members thereto.

NOW THEREFORE, it is resolved that the following appointments to the Canyon County Historic Preservation Commission be made for the terms below described and at the pleasure of this Board:

- George DeFord: 2-year term
- Zach Wesley: 1-year term
