

The Canyon County Board of Commissioners considered and adopted the following Resolution which shall be effective on the 1st day of May, 2023.

Upon the motion of Commissioner Van Beek and the second by Commissioner Brooks the Board resolves as follows:

To approve a **change to the base salary** of the Director, Facilities due to the additional functions assigned to him to manage the Weed and Pest Control Department. Rick Britton has taken on all the duties and responsibilities of an additional BOCC department (since 3/17/2023) to include budget preparation, staffing decisions and scheduling, work order delegation, pesticide inventory and ordering plus oversight of equipment and vehicle usage and modifications. He has exceeded these additional expectations of performance while continuing to effectively manage the multiple functions and deadlines of the Facilities Department.




No change to the title, job description or PCN of the Director, Facilities position are being requested at this time.
