Re: Canyon County Sheriff's Office and Landfill Reimbursement for Services

The solid waste enterprise landfill fund has an agreement with the Canyon County Sheriff's Office relating to the Sheriff's Inmate Labor Detail program (SILD). Through this program, individuals are allowed to serve their sentence on a work detail. The labor provides trash clean-up and other maintenance and facilities functions that are a necessary part of landfill operations and, as such, are to be reported as landfill operating expenses.

During FY25, 16,440 hours of the SILD program were dedicated to supporting landfill functions. The agreement specifies a reimbursement payment amount of \$15 per hour worked, equating to an amount of \$246,600 due and payable to the county justice fund.
