

RESOLUTION NO. 25-211

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CANYON COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY
COMMISSIONERS CONSENTING TO THE SALE OF
SURPLUS COUNTY PROPERTY**

The following Resolution was considered and adopted by the Board of County Commissioners of Canyon County, Idaho on the 4th day of November, 2025.

Upon the motion of Commissioner VanBeek and second by Commissioner Brooks, the Board resolves as follows:

WHEREAS, Idaho Code § 31-801 grants general powers and duties, subject to the restrictions of law, to the boards of county commissioners in their respective counties; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code § 31-828 grants the Board the authority “to do and perform all other acts . . . which may be necessary to the full discharge of the duties of the chief executive authority of the county government;” and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code § 31-807 authorizes the Board to manage county property subject to restrictions including, but not limited to, those described in Idaho Code § 31-808; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code § 31-829 permits the sale of personal property whenever any elective county officer determines that such personal property is of no further use to the county; and

WHEREAS, Canyon County is in possession of such personal property, described below, which has a fair trade-in value total of \$25,000 as determined by the Canyon County Solid Waste Director, and has been taken out of service by the Canyon County Solid Waste Director and is now surplus property:

2010 John Deere 772GP AWD Mtoro Grader S/N 1DW772GPCA0629951 with 11,114 Hours.

WHEREAS, Coastline Equipment has expressed an interest in receiving the above-described surplus property that is no longer needed by the County and has agreed to purchase the property at the fair-trade value as outlined in Exhibit A.

NOW THEREFORE, THE BOARD HEREBY FINDS, that the above-described personal property has been designated as surplus property, has been taken out of service by Canyon County, and is of use to the Coastline Equipment. Based on these findings, the Board further finds that sale of the personal property is in the public interest pursuant to Idaho Code § 31-808(9).
