

RESOLUTION NO. 26-016

A RESOLUTION OF THE CANYON COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY
COMMISSIONERS DESIGNATING A GENERAL RESERVE APPROPRIATION
EXPENDITURE IN THE FISCAL YEAR 2026 BUDGET
PURSUANT TO IDAHO CODE § 31-1605

The following resolution and order was considered and adopted by the Canyon County, Idaho Board of Commissioners ("Board") on this 16th day of February, 2026.

Upon the motion of Commissioner Brooks and the second by Commissioner Van Beek, the Board unanimously resolves as follows:

WHEREAS, Idaho Code § 31-801 grants general powers and duties, subject to the restrictions of law, to the boards of county commissioners in their respective counties; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code § 31-828 grants the Board authority "to do and perform all other acts . . . which may be necessary to the full discharge of the duties of the chief executive authority of the county government"; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code § 31-807 authorizes the Board to manage county property subject to restrictions including, but not limited to, those described in Idaho Code § 31-808; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code § 31-1605 provides that the Board may make a general reserve appropriation not to exceed five per cent (5%) of the final adopted current expense budget for any unforeseen contingency arising; and

WHEREAS, per Idaho Code § 31-1605 the general reserve funds may be appropriated to an office or department when an unforeseen contingency arises, which could not reasonably have been foreseen at the time of making the budget, and which requires the expenditure of money not provided for in the budget; and

WHEREAS, per Idaho Code § 31-160, such appropriation from the general reserve requires a unanimous vote of the board of county commissioners in such amount as shall be determined by resolution; and

WHEREAS, in the final Fiscal Year 2026 ("FY26") budget, the Board appropriated \$330,000.00 as a general reserve; and

WHEREAS, an unforeseen contingency, the opportunity to purchase an office container to serve as office space for sheriff deputies to station for work purposes located at the new Sheriff's training site next to the public George Nourse gun range, and a place to secure network

infrastructure to be used for camera surveillance, internet connectivity, gate access control, fiber optic connectivity, and to protect equipment from outside elements.




WHEREAS, the Board finds that an appropriation of a sum equal to the purchase price of the office container, but not to exceed \$39,794.96 from the general reserve to the FY26 budget and is in the best interests of Canyon County; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds that this adjustment shall cause no increase in anticipated property taxes.

NOW THEREFORE, THE BOARD HEREBY RESOLVES, that the Canyon County fiscal year 2026 budget be adjusted as described above.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE BOARD, that this resolution shall be effective this 6th day of February, 2026.
