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The Board of County Commissioners, sitting as a Board of Equalization, met today at 2:01 p.m. to conduct a property tax assessment protest hearing for Diamond L Development Inc., protest nos. 26079, 26080, 26081, & 26020. Present were: Commissioners Leslie Van Beek, Brad Holton and Zach Brooks, Chief Deputy Assessor Roger Craig, Chief Appraisal Supervisor Holly Hopkins, Assessor Brian Stender, Sr. Certified Property Appraiser Joni Irby, Certified Property Appraiser Supervisor Tracy Golder, Certified Property Appraiser Nicole Conrad, Other Assessor's Office staff, Gary Thomas, Mike Thomas, Jan Thomas, and Deputy Clerk Jenen Ross. Mike Thomas and Gary Thomas offered testimony in support of the protest application. Joni Irby, Roger Craig, and Tracy Golder offered testimony on behalf of the Assessor's Office. Upon the motion of Commissioner Brooks and second by Commissioner Holton the Board voted unanimously to recess from 2:51 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. Following the recess, there was some additional testimony, Board comments, and deliberation. Commissioner Brooks made a motion to uphold the Assessor's valuation for protest nos. 26079, 26080, 26081, and 26020. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Holton and carried unanimously.
