

RESOLUTION NO. 26-137

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF CANYON COUNTY, IDAHO, DELEGATING LIMITED CONTRACTING AUTHORITY TO THE FAIR DIRECTOR FOR CANYON COUNTY FAIR OPERATIONS

The following Resolution was considered and adopted by the Canyon County, Idaho Board of Commissioners (hereafter "Board") on this 30th day of June, 2026.

Upon the motion of Commissioner Van Beek and the second by Commissioner Brooks, the Board resolves as follows:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Idaho Code 31-801, the Canyon County Board of County Commissioners ("Board") has jurisdiction and power under such limitations and restrictions prescribed by law; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code § 31-801 grants general powers and duties, subject to the restrictions of law, to the boards of county commissioners in their respective counties; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code § 31-828 grants the Board authority "to do and perform all other acts . . . which may be necessary to the full discharge of the duties of the chief executive authority of the county government"; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code § 31-602 authorizes the Board to delegate purchasing and contracting authority to another elected official or county employee for purposes that serve the interests of the County; and

WHEREAS, the Board finds it appropriate to require prior approval before the Fair Director executes any contract, agreement, or other obligation on behalf of the County with a total value exceeding Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000), to ensure proper oversight of County expenditures and contractual commitments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Canyon County that the Fair Director is hereby authorized to execute contracts, agreements, and other documents necessary for the operation and administration of the Canyon County Fair, provided that the total value of any such contract, agreement, or obligation does not exceed Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000); and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any contract, agreement, or obligation exceeding Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000) shall require prior approval of the Board of County Commissioners before execution.
