

RESOLUTION NO. 26-154

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CANYON COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY
COMMISSIONERS DESIGNATING SURPLUS PROPERTY AND
DONATING TO ADAMS COUNTY**

The following resolution and order was considered and adopted by the Canyon County, Idaho Board of Commissioners ("Board") on this 18th day of August, 2026.

Upon the motion of Commissioner Van Boek and the second by Commissioner Brooks, the Board resolves as follows:

WHEREAS, Idaho Code § 31-801 grants general powers and duties, subject to the restrictions of law, to the boards of county commissioners in their respective counties; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code § 31-828 grants the Board authority "to do and perform all other acts . . . which may be necessary to the full discharge of the duties of the chief executive authority of the county government"; and

WHEREAS, Idaho Code § 31-807 authorizes the Board to manage county property subject to restrictions including, but not limited to, those described in Idaho Code § 31-808; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Idaho Code § 31-808(9), the Board of County Commissioners may grant any item of personal property, with or without compensation, to any political subdivision or the State of Idaho if such grant of property is in the public interest; and

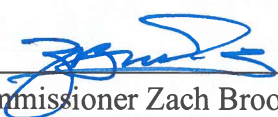
WHEREAS, Canyon County, Idaho is no longer in need of certain personal property that is now surplus property such as used desks, office chairs, bookshelves more fully described and viewed in attached Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, such personal property has minimal current value as each is no longer of use to the Canyon County.

NOW THEREFORE, THE BOARD HEREBY FINDS that the property is designated as surplus property, is of nominal value, and it is in the public interest to grant the property to Adams County, Idaho.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE BOARD, that this resolution shall be effective this 18th day of August, 2026.
